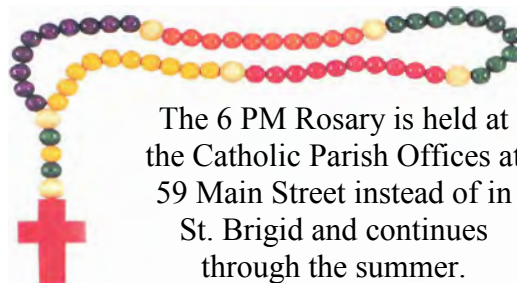

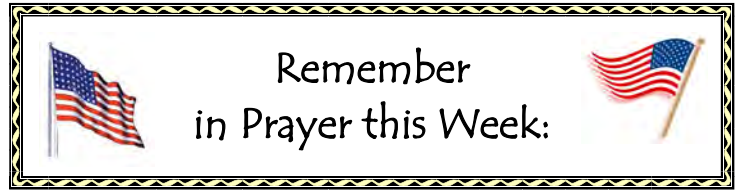

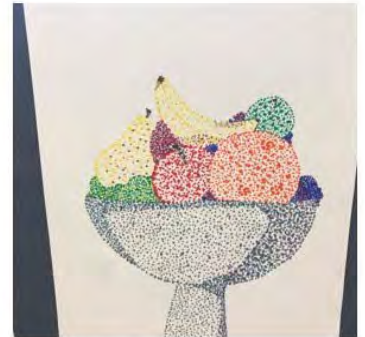

Assumption School "An Evening for the Arts"

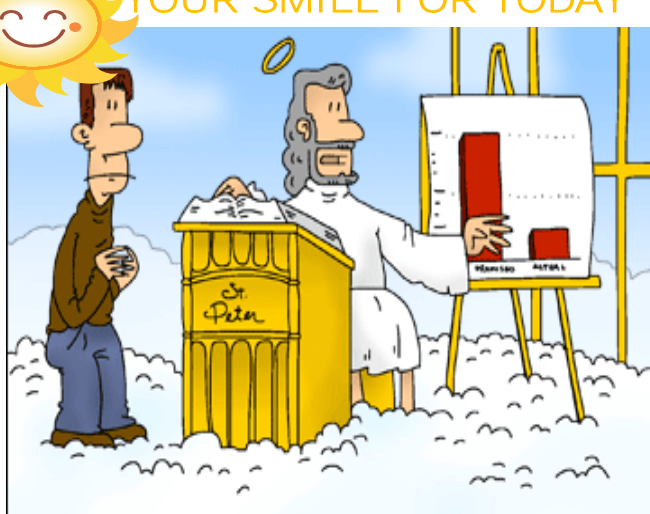
