

A Message from Fr. Paolo

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As many of you know I have spent 10 years as missionary priest in Taiwan before coming to the United States. The Church in China is very dear to me. This past Tuesday, July 9th we celebrated the feast of the 120 Martyrs of China: "men and women of every age and state, priests, religious and lay people, showed the same conviction and joy, sealing their unfailing fidelity to Christ and the Church with the gift of their lives" (St. John Paull II, October 1, 2000).

Among these 120 martyr saints there was a well-off doctor St. Mark Ji TianXiang who was actually an opium addict. His life is a beautiful witness to the grace of God that can make great saints of the most unlikely among us. For years TianXiang was a respectable Christian but when he became ill with a stomach ailment started to treat himself with opium. He soon became addict to opium smoking and he used to go frequently to confession but times were different and addiction was not understood as a disease: since TianXiang kept confessing the same sin over and over again, the priest thought he was not really repented and so told the poor man he couldn't absolve him unless he became sober. Uncapable of overcoming his addiction TianXiang still kept going to mass even if he couldn't receive the sacraments. He kept showing up in church for 30 years. For 30 years he prayed he would die a martyr. In 1900, when the Boxer Rebellion exploded and rebels started to target foreigners and Christians, TianXiang and his family were rounded up and imprisoned. While he was uncapable of beating his addiction, TianXiang showed himself unshakable in his trust in the Lord. He begged his captors to kill him last so that none of his family would have to die alone. In the end, he went to his death singing the Litanies of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Let's ask for St. Mark's intercession for all addicts and for all of us, that we may have the courage to be faithful to the Church and always grow in our love and trust in the Lord. St. Mark Ji TianXiang, pray for us!
