

CONFESSION DURING ADVENT

Advent is a period of time when the Church reminds us that we are waiting not only to celebrate Christmas and the Lord's birth, but we are also waiting for the Lord's Second Coming. In either case, we are encouraged to prepare ourselves for either by going to confession. All of us have seen the power and effects of evil in our world. Most, if not all of us, have experienced the power of sin in our lives. Our experience is similar to what St. Paul describes the inner conflict between good and evil in his letter to the Romans... "I cannot even understand my own actions. I do not do what I want to do but what I hate.... which indicates that sin resides in me. What happens is that I do not the good I will to do, but the evil I do not intend. Who will save me from this...Jesus Christ" (Romans 8:15-19). Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 9:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. -3:45 p.m. in the lower church or by appointment.
