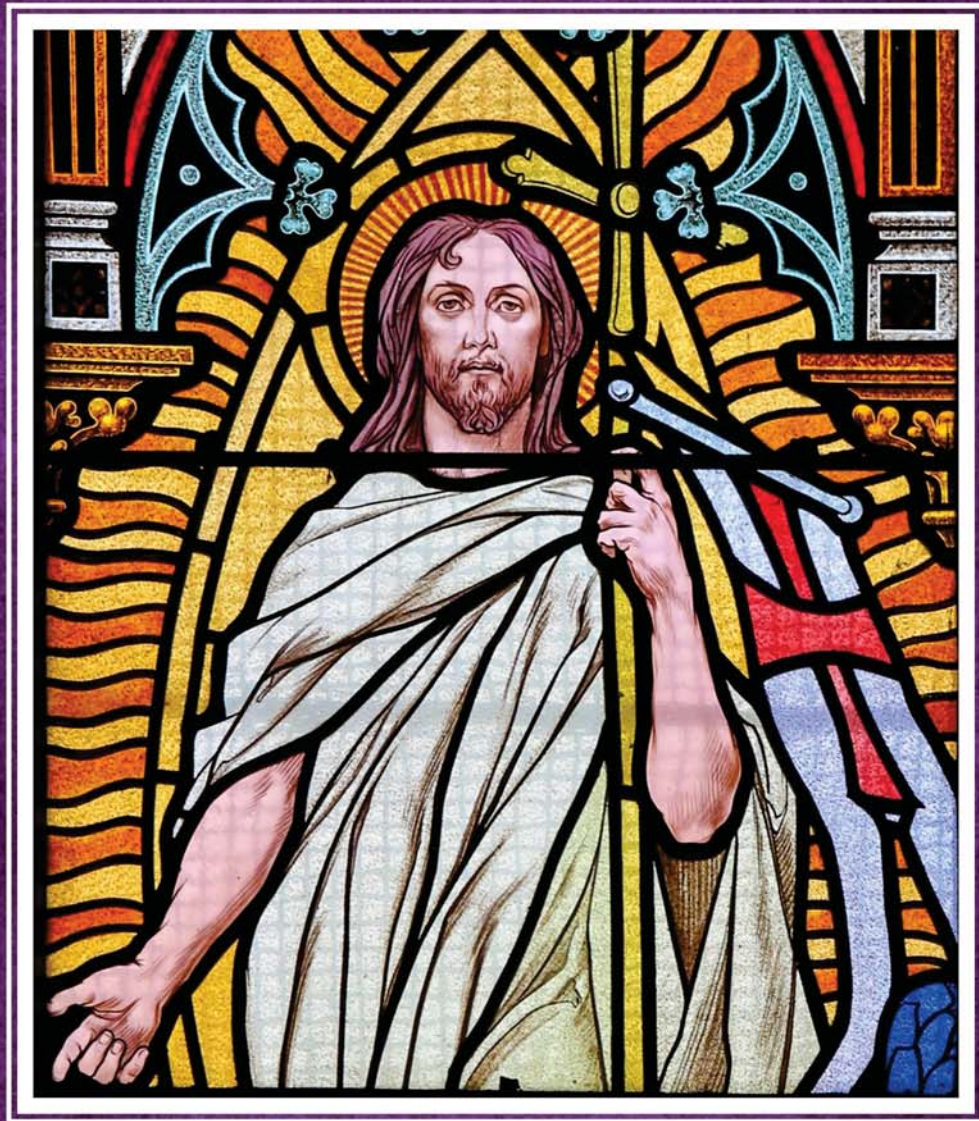

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE: Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used at all.

FAST: Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of fasting. On these days, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, enough to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal one full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed.

RCIA

The Rite of Election and the Scrutinies

On February 18, at a prayer service at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross, Sean and Brian, our catechumens, signed their names in the Book of the Elect. Cardinal Sean O'Malley, OFM Cap, asked them and 358 other Catechumens from across the archdiocese to affirm that they "... wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist". He then declared them to be members of the Elect, "to be initiated into the sacred mysteries at the Easter Vigil." This week, and the following two weeks, they will participate in the Scrutinies. The Scrutinies will be celebrated at Saint Theresa of Avila Church at the 4:30 Mass on Saturday, March 2, at the 10 A.M. Mass on Sunday, March 10, and at the 8 A.M. Mass on Sunday, March 17. The ritual explains that, "The scrutinies ... are rites for self-searching and repentance and have, above all a spiritual purpose. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful; to bring out, then strengthen, all that is upright, strong, and good.... The scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ. Because they are asking for the three sacraments of initiation, the elect must have the intention of achieving an intimate knowledge of Christ and His Church and they are expected particularly to progress in genuine self-knowledge through serious examination of their lives and true repentance" (RCIA 141-142) Please continue to keep Sean and Brian in your prayers.

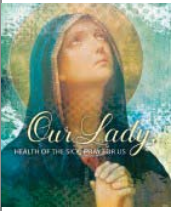

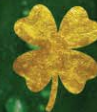

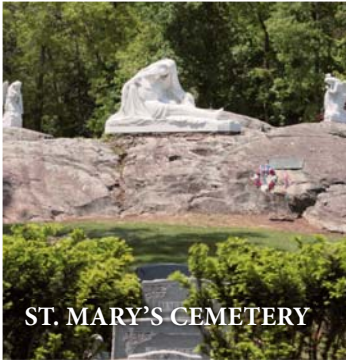
